Worship Team Guidelines:

Thank you for being willing to share your God-given talents in music and worship.

- 1. Must live a life for Christ at all times, according to the Bible and ICF Rome Spiritual Tenants of Faith (http://agchurches.org/Sitefiles/Default/RSS/AG.org%20TOP/Beliefs/SFT_2011.pdf).
- 2. Be willing and ready for rehearsals, services and special events as scheduled.
- 3. Study and practice music given prior to services.
- 4. We strive for a level of excellence and integrity in our ministry teams. Your responsibility is to remain faithful and consistent in your music involvement.
- 5. We provide teaching tools on a regular basis and ask all musicians to remain with a teachable spirit and availability for learning sessions.

The Audition Process:

You will choose a song that you feel best displays your abilities.

Learn the song. If you are in need of lyrics, charts, or a band to play along with you to either sing or play with, organize that with the Worship Minister.

A time will be set up for you to audition. You will sing a song or play a song and then it will be decided what best position is available for you on the team.

If there are technical items for you to work on it, will be stated to you after your audition in order to help you grow musically.
